- 3. List Leadership experiences designed to aid others involved with dairy goats.
- 4. List other activities you have been involved in during your college years including sports, band, cheerleading, academic decathalon, debate, etc. How have these activities contributed to your growth as an individual?
- 5. Write a double-spaced essay describing the history of one's dairy goat project. Discuss how and why you chose the project, the progress you have made, what you have gained, and your plans for the future of your project.
