- 1) Please attach a copy of the DHIR INDIVIDUAL DOE PAGE for lactation completed by March 15th of the current year for each nominated doe. These are the only lactation records that will be accepted as proof. Owner-Sampler Advanced records will be accepted for production awards. They must be accompanied by the following: Copy of proof of verification test; copy of proof of tester certification from DRPC; and proof of minimum of 8 tests per year. All Owner-Sampler Advanced records will be identified with an asterisk (*) on both the website and in publications.
- These awards are open to Purebreds, Americans, Experimentals and Grades owned by members of the American LaMancha Club. Recorded Grades animals must meet the ADGA breed standard for LaManchas.
- 3) All youth entering the production contest with qualifying does will receive a separate youth award for participation.
- 4) Check box next to qualifying description below. Complete form and mail or email with photocopies, together with appropriate fees to chairman listed below. DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES TO BE RECEIVED IS APRIL 10TH of CURRENT YEAR
- 5) An ALBA member must be the current owner of the animal whose records are being submitted. The Production program is open to all ALBA members in good standing, (dues current). Non-members may join ALBA concurrently, providing that the \$15.00 annual membership fee is also enclosed. All payments must be included with entry forms. Membership must be paid by the time the entries are submitted and will be for the current year. NOTE: you may nominate a doe/buck for Diamond Sire/Dam award if you don't own the buck/doe BUT own all of his/her qualifying offspring.
- 6) Each year the pictures of production winners are submitted to the newsletter and website, and other dairy goat publications.. If you are interested in having your doe's picture published please attach your photos to your online entry. Photoss are NOT required to enter and if you do not attach one, it will be assumed that you do not want a picture published. Hard copy photos will not be accepted as all publications now require electronic photos and scanned photos do not reproduce as well. Photos must be of the animal in milk...no junior doe photos accepted.

 Animals must have been appraised in the year preceding nomination (2019 nominations must have been appraised in 2018).
- 3) These awards are open to Purebreds, Americans, Experimentals and Grades owned by members of the American LaMancha Breeders Association. Recorded Grades animals must meet the ADGA breed standard for LaManchas. Entries that do not meet one of these requirements will be returned.
- 4) All youth entering the production contest with qualifying does will receive a separate youth award for participation.

- 6) An ALBA member must be the current owner of the animal whose records are being submitted. The Production program is open to all ALBA members in good standing, (dues current). A perfect appetizer for your Valentine's Day celebration!


