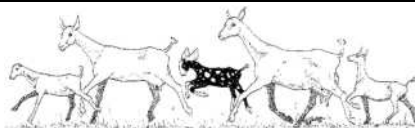

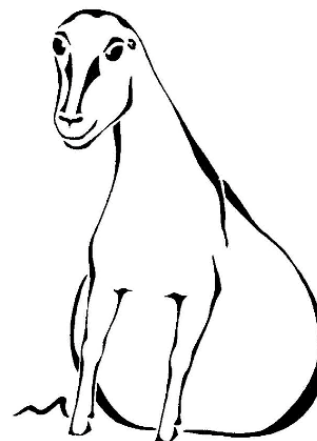

1) Please attach a copy of the DHIR INDIVIDUAL DOE PAGE for lactation completed by March 15th of the current year for each nominated doe. These are the only lactation records that will be accepted as proof. **Owner-Sampler Advanced records will be accepted for production awards. They must be accompanied by the following: Copy of proof of verification test; copy of proof of tester certification from DRPC; and proof of minimum of 8 tests per year. All Owner-Sampler Advanced records will be identified with an asterisk (\*) on both the website and in publications.**

2) These awards are open to Purebreds, Americans, Experimentals and Grades owned by members of the American LaMancha Club. Recorded Grades animals must meet the ADGA breed standard for LaManchas.

3) All youth entering the production contest with qualifying does will receive a separate youth award for participation.

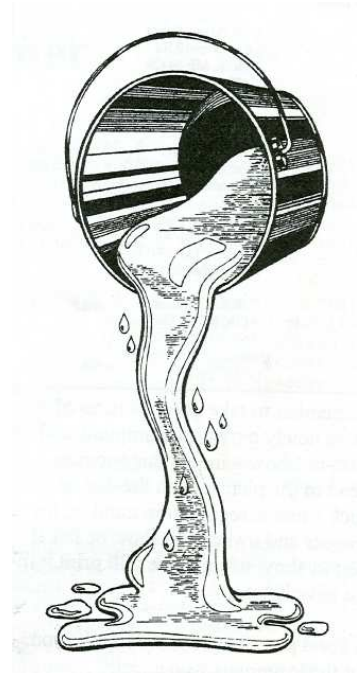

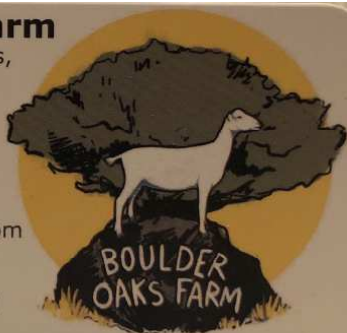

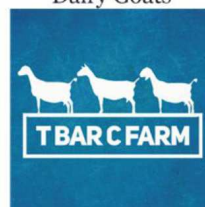

*A perfect appetizer for your Valentine's Day celebration!*

4 oz goat cheese, crumbled

1 sm. Garlic clove, finely chopped

2 tsp finely chopped fresh parsley

1/8 tsp. sea salt

16 dried dates, cut in half, pits removed



1. Combine goat cheese, garlic, parsley and salt in small bowl and mash with fork until blended.
2. Spoon a heaping teaspoon of mixture into each split date. Serve immediately or refrigerate dates up to 2 hours, covered, and then warm to room temperature and serve

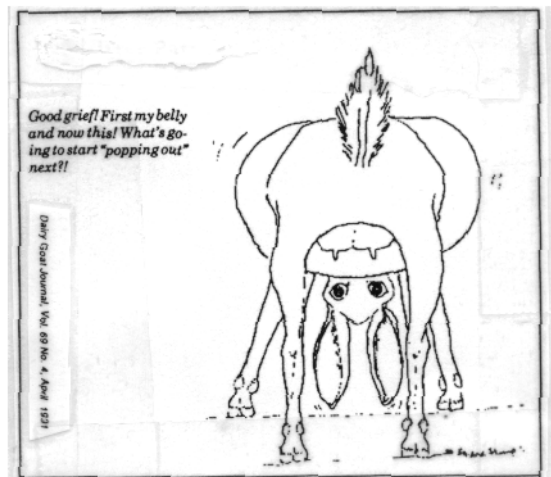
